ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE
FOR BACK-UP/STANDBY TARIFFS
(January 23, 2020)

Pursuant to the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) Rules Chapter 2, Section 16, notice is hereby given that on December 19, 2019, Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy (CLFP) and Black Hills Power, Inc. d/b/a Black Hills Energy (BHP) filed an *Unopposed Motion to Extend Deadline for Back-up/Standby Tariffs (Motion)* requesting that the February 1, 2020 deadline to file the back-up/standby tariffs be extended through April 1, 2020. CLFP and BHP stated in their *Motion* that the Intervenor, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) and Walmart, Inc., have no objections to the requested extension.

CLFP and BHP's *Motion* came before the Commission for consideration, pursuant to due notice, at its Open Meeting on January 7, 2020. Jana Smoot White, Counsel, appeared by telephone for CLFP and BHP. Ms. White explained the requested extension of the February 1, 2020, deadline was filed because CLFP and BHE have been working internally with the OCA and wish to engage in more meaningful collaboration prior to filing the back-up/standby tariffs with the Commission. Commission Staff recommended the Commission grant the *Motion*.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy and Black Hills Power, Inc. d/b/a Black Hills Energy's *Unopposed Motion to Extend Deadline for Back-up/Standby Tariffs* is granted.

2. Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy and Black Hills Power, Inc. d/b/a Black Hills Energy's deadline to file back-up/standby tariffs is extended through April 1, 2020.
