A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 24-2-108 relating to road and bridge
 2 construction; raising the dollar limits under which the
 3 highway commission may execute emergency work without sub-
 4 mitting the work to bid; and providing for an effective
 5 date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 24-2-108 is amended to read:

8 24-2-108. Road and bridge construction generally.

9 All road and bridge construction work, any part of the
 10 cost of which is paid from the state highway fund, shall
 11 be performed in accordance with the plans and specifica-

1 tions prepared by the state highway superintendent and
2 approved by the commission, and shall be performed by or
3 under contracts awarded by the commission. The state high-
4 way superintendent shall have complete charge thereof,
5 including expenditures for roads now in existence, or in
6 the future to be constructed, which are part of state
7 highway systems which are located within or partially
8 within the national forests' boundaries. All improvements
9 costing more than ~~twenty~~ FIFTY thousand dollars
10 ~~(\$20,000.00)~~ (\$50,000.00) shall be constructed upon con-
11 tracts awarded after public notice to the lowest respon-
12 sible bidder determined qualified by the state highway
13 commission of Wyoming which is hereby given the power to
14 determine the qualifications and responsibilities of bid-
15 ders. The commission may reject any or all bids and
16 readvertise for bids. Improvements costing less than
17 ~~twenty~~ FIFTY thousand dollars ~~(\$20,000.00)~~ (\$50,000.00)
18 may be constructed by the commission upon force account,
19 with its own forces or upon contract, as the commission
20 may determine. A state highway construction job to be com-
21 pleted within any calendar year period and to cost more
22 than ~~twenty~~ FIFTY thousand dollars ~~(\$20,000.00)~~
23 (\$50,000.00) shall not be constructed by Wyoming highway
24 department forces in sections or parcels so as to come
25 within the ~~twenty~~ FIFTY thousand dollar ~~(\$20,000.00)~~

1 (\$50,000.00) limitation. Contracts may be entered into
2 with railroad companies for the construction of grade
3 separation structures at actual cost under terms and
4 conditions approved by the commission. ~~Whenever~~ IF an
5 emergency arises requiring immediate expenditure of funds
6 for the repair or rebuilding of bridges, approaches to
7 bridges and any roadway, when ~~such~~ THE bridges, approaches
8 to bridges or roadway are required to be rebuilt immedi-
9 ately and on such short time that in the judgment of the
10 state highway commission the people would be seriously
11 inconvenienced in waiting the regular period for advertis-
12 ing for bids, the state highway commission may enter into
13 contract for any such building or rebuilding of bridges,
14 approaches or roadway without advertising ~~for~~ the letting
15 of any contract therefor, provided the amount of ~~such~~ THE
16 contract shall not exceed ~~fifty~~ ONE HUNDRED thousand
17 dollars ~~(\$50,000.00)~~ (\$100,000.00). The commission shall
18 adopt general rules and regulations for the publication of
19 notice to bidders, the awarding of contracts, and for
20 determining the qualifications and responsibilities of
21 bidders.

22 Section 2. This act is effective May 25, 1979.



10 judgment of the state highway commission the people would
11 be seriously inconvenienced in waiting the regular period
12 for advertising for bids, the state highway commission may
13 enter into contract for any such building or rebuilding of
14 bridges, approaches or roadway without advertising for the
15 letting of any contract therefor, provided the amount of
16 such THE contract shall not exceed ~~fifty~~ ONE HUNDRED thou-
17 sand dollars ~~(\$50,000.00)~~ (\$100,000.00). The commission
18 shall adopt general rules and regulations for the publi-
19 cation of notice to bidders, the awarding of contracts,
20 and for determining the qualifications and responsibili-
21 ties of bidders.

22 Section 2. This act is effective May 25, 1979.
