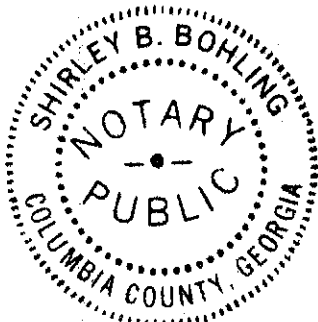

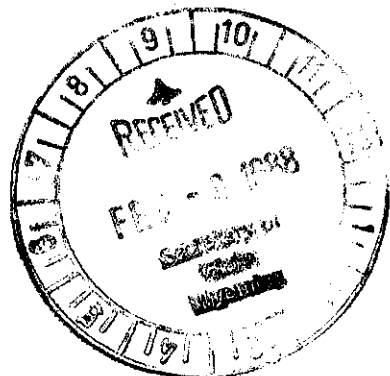

Dear Ms. Sawyer:

This letter is in response to your trademark objection letter dated February 9, 1988, a copy of which is enclosed. Your letter indicated your belief that the mark "Morris News Service" appears to be a business name or trade name that is not registrable. We respectfully submit that the display and use of the mark in the heading of news stories distributed by the Applicant serve to identify the Applicant's news stories and to distinguish them from others. Therefore, we believe the mark does indeed serve as a service mark.

Initially, we would like to point out that the Applicant filed a service mark application with the United States Patent Office at or about the same time that this application was filed in Wyoming. As evidenced by the enclosed Notice of Publication, the Federal Examiner has approved the Federal service mark application, obviously concluding that the mark functions as more than a trade name. Similar to Wyoming law, the Federal law does not provide for the registration of a business name or trade name.

As stated in In re Unclaimed Salvage and Freight Co., Inc., 192 USPC 165, 167 (TTAB 1976), "a trade name used as such cannot be registered under the provisions of the Lanham Act". However, this case states that it is well established that a term may function both as a trade name and as a service mark and/or trademark. With respect to the Morris News

Service application, we do not deny that in some instances the mark may be used to identify the Applicant's business; but we submit that the mark is primarily used to identify services rendered by the Applicant. When a newspaper prints a news story bearing "Morris News Service" in the heading, the mark identifies the source of the news story and distinguishes the story from those distributed by other agencies, such as the Associated Press or United Press International. The mark is used to identify the news services provided by Morris Communications Corporation and its subsidiaries (none of which are named "Morris News Service").

In view of our foregoing analysis, and in view of the action by the U. S. Patent Office under similar rules, we respectfully request that you reconsider the application and determine that the mark functions as a service mark. We hope that this letter will provide sufficient justification for your issuance of a service mark registration, but please do not hesitate to contact us if you would like further information. Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated.

Capitol fight enters high court

ATLANTA — It's not every day that the governor and attorney general sit on opposite sides of the Georgia Supreme Court while their lawyers argue which of the two the drafters of the state constitution intended to favor.

Tuesday was historic.

Not a seat was left vacant as lawyers and aides jostled with reporters and law students for a view of a precedent-setting case to unscramble a constitutional crisis.

"I don't think we'll see a case this impor-

tant in the next century," said Attorney General Thurbert Baker.

The outcome could alter the daily workings of state government and forever change the power of Georgia's statewide elected officials.

Chief Justice Norman Fletcher said as much when he explained at the beginning of oral arguments that the court would take as long as it needed to decide the case since it is so important.

Before the seven-member high court is Gov. Sonny Perdue's lawsuit against Mr. Baker.

Mr. Perdue wants the court to order the

attorney general to do as the governor tells him. In this case, Mr. Perdue ordered Mr. Baker to withdraw an appeal pending before the U.S. Supreme Court dealing with the state Senate district map drawn up by Democrats. When Mr. Baker refused, Mr. Perdue sued him.

Mr. Perdue told reporters after Tuesday's hearing he didn't have a grudge against Mr. Baker.

"This is not a personal issue between the attorney general and me," he said.

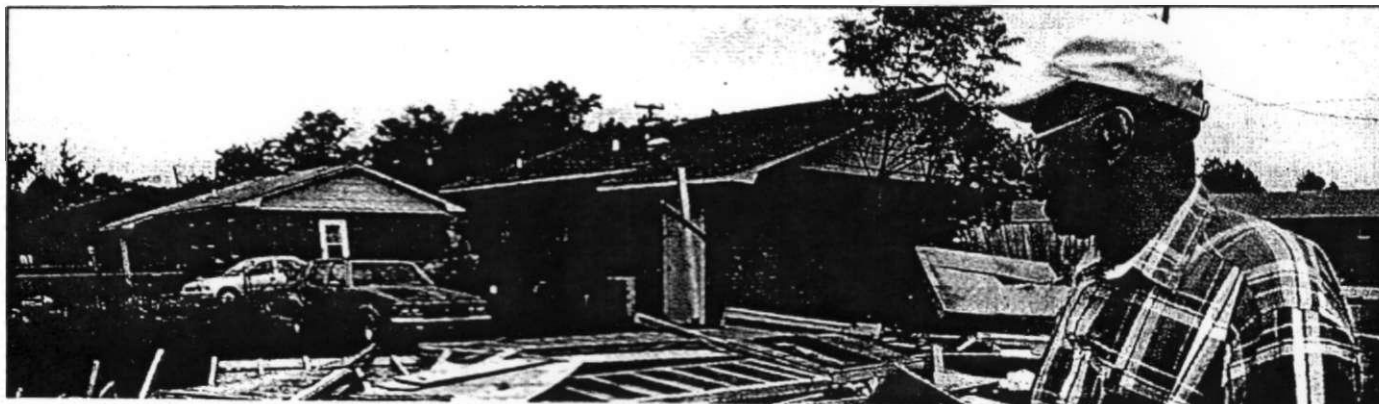

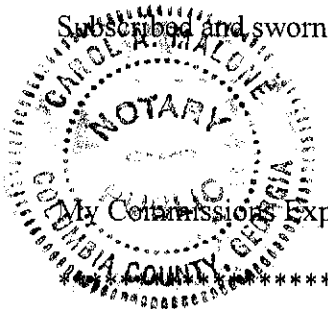

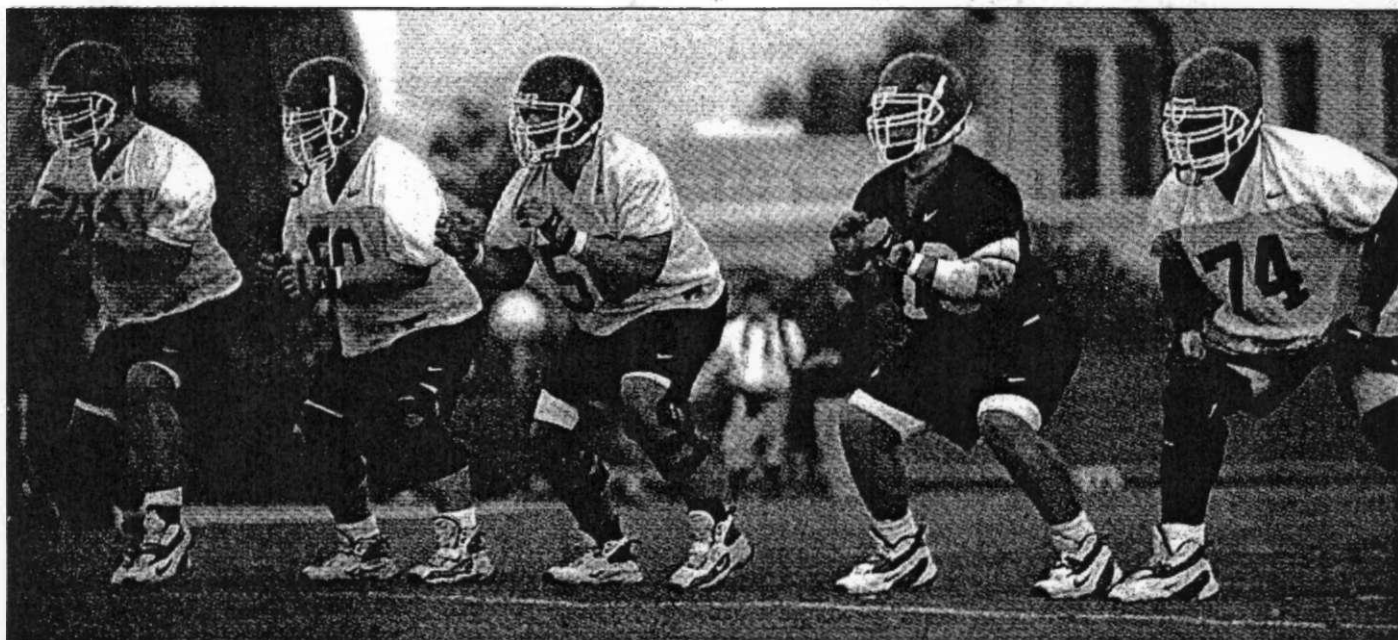

Young players will fill offensive line openings

ATHENS, Ga. — Mark Richt doesn't envy the job in front of Georgia offensive line coach Neil Callaway.

The Bulldogs signed seven offensive linemen this year, and, because of the team's lack of depth, Callaway predicts two or three of them will have to play significant minutes this year.

Which two or three has yet to be determined, Callaway said, but the candidates include tackles Trey Chandler and Ken Shackelford, guards Fernando Velasco of Jefferson County, Zeb McKinzey and Tommy Gainous and center Nick Jones.

Only six linemen — the starting five and reserve tackle Dennis Roland — have

ing Monday afternoon's practice, Shackelford, Velasco, McKinzey and Jones worked with the second-team line.

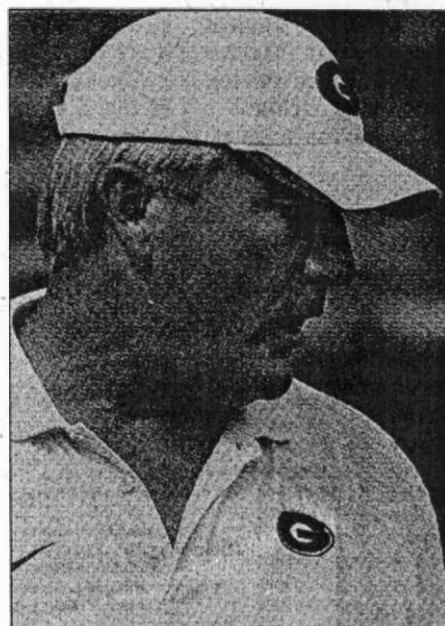
"Ideally, you'd like to have about 10 guys you feel good about," he said.

Jones is working at No. 2 center because of an injury to Michael Turner, and Chandler is battling Shackelford for the fourth tackle position. Sophomores Reggie Weeks and walk-on Ryan Schnetzer are listed as the No. 2 guards, but Monday's lineup suggests the depth chart may look different by the time the season opens Aug. 30 at Clemson.

"There's definitely that feel of we know we have a shot to play," McKinzey said.

Saturday, the team's first day of full contact, was eye-opening for the freshmen. Georgia's No. 2 offensive line, where most of the freshmen are rotating, faces the No. 1 defensive line — as Richt describes it, "(David) Pollack and company."

"It's really not fair for them," he said.

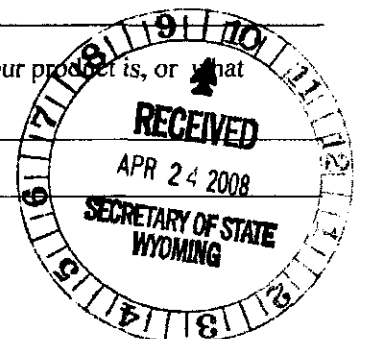

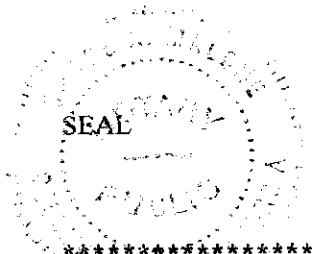

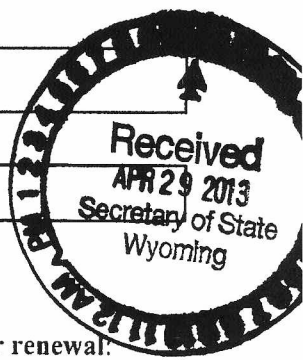
