1. Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given that a public hearing is scheduled regarding the Application of Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy (CLFP or the Company) requesting authority to increase its power cost adjustment (PCA) by \$0.00243 per kilowatt hour (kWh) effective July 1, 2020. **The public hearing is set to commence on Tuesday, December 15, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming.**

2. CLFP conducts business as Black Hills Energy and is a wholly owned subsidiary of Black Hills Corporation. CLFP is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112. CLFP is engaged in the business of supplying electric utility service to customers throughout its service territory in Laramie County and the City of Cheyenne.

3. On April 30, 2020, CLFP filed its Application, requesting authority to implement a 2020 PCA rate of \$0.00563 per kWh, an increase of \$0.00243 per kWh from the Company's currently effective PCA rate of \$0.00320 per kWh. On July 9, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order* granting CLFP's *Motion*, requesting authority to implement its proposed PCA rate of \$0.00563 per kWh, on an interim basis, subject to refund and adjustment, effective July 1, 2020.

4. All interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing which will be conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyoming Public Service Commission Rules, **and subject to any applicable national, state or local public health related orders or directives.** All interested persons may appear and be heard, in person, by video or telephone conference, or through counsel appearing in person or by video or telephone conference.
