5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 31-5-123 is created to read:

7 31-5-123. Funeral processions; right-of-way; limita-
 8 tions.

9 (a) A funeral procession led by a funeral car or

2 lights authorized under W.S. 31-5-928 has the right-of-way
3 in the lane or portion of the roadway upon which it is
4 traveling subject to the following:

5 (i) The driver of the lead vehicle of the pro-
6 cession shall comply with all traffic control devices.
7 Vehicles in the procession displaying headlamps may follow
8 the lead vehicle without stopping at stop signs or traffic
9 signals. Vehicles in the procession shall yield the
10 right-of-way to authorized emergency vehicles;

11 (ii) Vehicles in a funeral procession shall be
12 driven on the right-hand side of the roadway and, if a
13 laned roadway, in the right-hand lane nearest the right-
14 hand edge of the roadway;

15 (iii) Vehicles in a funeral procession shall
16 follow the vehicle ahead as close as is reasonable and
17 prudent;

18 (iv) Vehicles in a funeral procession shall be
19 driven at a speed within the existing speed limit consis-
20 tent with safety and traffic conditions;

21 (v) No driver of a vehicle shall pass any
22 vehicle in a funeral procession operated upon a roadway

1 with only two (2) lanes;

2 (vi) No driver of a vehicle shall drive
3 between vehicles in a funeral procession displaying head-
4 lamps unless the vehicle is part of the procession;

5 (vii) Drivers of oncoming vehicles are not
6 required to yield the right-of-way to funeral processions
7 but shall proceed normally.

8 Section 2. This act is effective June 11, 1986.
