An Act to amend and re-enact Section 763 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming of I899, concerning the sale of unclaimed lots in public townsites.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section I. That Section 763 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming of 1899, be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

\* Section 763. If all the lots, blocks, shares or parcels of such land are not legally conveyed to the proper owners before the expiration of one year after the same shall have been passed upon by the corporate authorities or judge or in case of contest, within thirty days after such contest shall have been legally determined, the same shall be sold to the highest bidder, and the proceeds turned over and transferred to the acting corporate authorities of such city or town by the judge or trustees named in this chapter and applied by said acting corporate authorities to the erection of public buildings, water works, sewerage systems or parks for the benefit of such city or town, after paying their proportionate share of the purchase money and other expenses. including expenses incurred by publication and sale. All moneys heretofore for hereafter obtained from the sale of said lots, blocks, shares or parcels of land shall be disposed of in like manner and as above specified. Notice of the sale authorized by this section shall be published as is required by section seven hundred and fifty seven; provided that the provisions of this section shall not apply to the sale of real estate belonging to minors or insane persons, except upon order of court authorizing such sale, which order may be made by the court upon an exparte application under oath of the trustees named in this chapter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
