6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-3-116 and 33-3-120(f)(intro) are
9 amended to read:

10

11 **33-3-116. Waiver of examination; holders of**
12 **certificates in sister states or foreign countries.** The
13 board may waive the examination and may issue a certificate
14 as a certified public accountant to any person who meets the
15 requirements specified in W.S. ~~33-3-109(a)(ii) and (iii)~~
16 33-3-109(a)(iv) and who is the holder of a certificate as a
17 certified public accountant, then in full force and effect,

1 issued under the laws of any state, or who is a holder of a
2 certificate, license or degree from a foreign country
3 constituting a recognized qualification for the practice of
4 public accounting in that country, comparable to that of a
5 certified public accountant of Wyoming.

7 **33-3-120. Permits; annual fee; renewal; requirements.**

8

9 (f) No holder of a certificate issued under W.S.
10 33-3-109 shall be issued a permit under subsection (a) of
11 this section unless he has at least two (2) years experience
12 in the practice of public accounting. No holder of a
13 certificate issued under W.S. 33-3-116 who has not met the
14 educational requirements stipulated in W.S. 33-3-109(a)(iii)
15 shall be issued a permit under subsection (a) of this
16 section unless he has not less than five (5) years
17 experience in the practice of public accounting within the
18 past ten (10) years immediately preceding his application
19 for a certificate. The experience must include tax work and
20 the preparation of financial statements in accordance with
21 standards promulgated by the American Institute of Certified
22 Public Accountants. The applicant shall:
