ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

THIS MATTER came before the State Board of Equalization (State Board) on its own motion. The State Board, having reviewed the file herein and being otherwise advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. The Wyoming State Board of Equalization issued a Scheduling Conference Order to Rock Creek Resources LLC (Petitioner) and to the Department of Revenue (Department) dated April 22, 2021.
2. The Scheduling Conference Order directed that Petitioner had until May 24, 2021 to file its preliminary statement with the State Board, and to serve the same with the Department of Revenue;
3. The Scheduling Conference Order also set a Scheduling Conference for June 14, 2021 at 10:00 and provided that the parties could attend the conference by telephone if they informed the State Board in advance of their intent to do so;
4. Petitioner did not file its Preliminary Statement as required;
5. On June 2, 2021, the State Board issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss with Prejudice informing the parties of its intent to dismiss the appeal on or after June 17, 2021 unless a party filed specific written objections to dismissal before that date;


6. On June 11, 2021, Petitioner sent the State Board, by email, a letter asking it to forego dismissing the appeal. Petitioner explained that it thought the Notice of Intent to Dismiss had closed out the appeal. Petitioner did not, however, file its Preliminary Statement, explain why it had failed to file its Preliminary Statement, explain how any reasonable reader could believe that the Notice of Intent to Dismiss had closed out the appeal, or explain why the State Board should not dismiss the appeal;
7. Petitioner did not attend the June 14, 2021 Scheduling Conference;
8. Petitioner has repeatedly failed to comply with the State Board's rules and orders.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, in keeping with Chapter 1, Section 9(e), and Chapter 2, Section 21 of the State Board's rules, that this matter is dismissed with prejudice.

Pursuant to Wyoming Statutes section 16-3-114 (2019) and Rule 12, Wyoming Rules of Appellate Procedure, any person aggrieved or adversely affected in fact by this decision may seek judicial review in the appropriate district court by filing a petition for review within 30 days after the date of this decision.


