A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to worker's compensation; granting loan
2 authority from pooled fund investments to pay benefits
3 from the worker's compensation account; and providing for
4 an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. Upon certification of inadequate revenues
7 by the director of the department of employment to the
8 state treasurer, the state treasurer may loan funds from
9 pooled fund investments to the worker's compensation
10 account. Loans under this section shall not exceed a
11 total cumulative amount of twenty-five million dollars

1 (\$25,000,000.00) and shall be used as necessary to pay
2 benefits payable through June 30, 1994 required under the
3 Wyoming Worker's Compensation Act which cannot be paid
4 because of insufficient revenues available to the worker's
5 compensation account. The unpaid balance of any loan
6 under this section shall bear interest at a rate equal to
7 the average interest rate earned on pooled fund invest-
8 ments for the fiscal year immediately preceding the fiscal
9 year in which the loan is made and interest payments shall
10 be in accordance with a schedule established by the state
11 treasurer. All loans under this section shall be paid in
12 full by July 1, 1999.

13 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
16 tution.

Passage of this bill would enable the Workers' Compensation Division the authority to borrow up to \$25 million from pooled funds to pay benefits through June 30, 1995. Any loans shall be repaid by July 1, 1999, and shall bear interest at a rate equal to the rate earned on pooled investments for the preceding fiscal year.
