House Joint Resolutions No 8.

Providing for the election of
a Joint Committee of three
to proceed to Washington D.C. upon
the defeat of any measure before
Congress, seeking to transfer the
Yellowstone National Park to any
other jurisdiction.

It is enacted by the House of
Representatives of the Territory of
Wyoming, the Council concurring
therein,

That a joint committee to
consist of ~~one~~ ^{two} members of the
Council and ~~two~~ ^{two} members of the
House of Representatives of the
eighteenth Legislative Assembly of
the Territory of Wyoming be elected
for a joint convention of both houses
to be held at 3 o'clock P.M. on
Friday March 9th A.D. 1884 in
the Hall of the House of Rep-
resentatives, who shall on or be-
fore the 10th day of March A.D.
then leave for Washington D.C.
and who are instructed to urge
upon Congress the necessity of
defeating any measure before either
House tending to seek or tending
to transfer the Territory embraced

within the limits of the Yellow
stone National Park to any other
jurisdiction or endeavoring to ex-
tend the jurisdiction of any other
territory over said Park.

X That the sum of ~~one~~ ^{five}
~~thousand~~ dollars is as much more
of as is necessary, for the in-
come is, being appropriated out
of the ^{any fund} ~~Central~~ Treasury not
otherwise appropriated to pay the
expenses of such committee to
nothing but the return.

That each member of such
joint committee shall be re-
imbursed for his actual expenses in
such service. And before being re-
imbursed the member shall file his
account with the Central Audit-
or verified by his oath that he
has necessarily and actually ex-
pended the amount claimed. And has
faithfully labored for and his ut-
most endeavor for at least ten
days, to prevent the passage of
a law seeking to transfer the
jurisdiction of the Yellowstone
National Park to any other ter-
ritory.
