WORKER'S COMPENSATION-NURSE PRACTITIONER PROVIDERS

Original House Bill No. 317

AN ACT relating to worker's compensation; amending the definition of "health care provider" to allow advanced practitioners of nursing to provide health care services under the worker's compensation program; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 27-14-102(a)(x) is amended to read:

27-14-102. Definitions.

- (a) As used in this act:
- (x) "Health care provider" means doctor of medicine, chiropractic or osteopathy, dentist, optometrist, podiatrist, or psychologist or advanced practitioner of nursing, acting within the scope of his license, licensed to practice in this state or in good standing in his home state;

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
