APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF TRADE MARK

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

The undersigned, Campbell Soup Company,

being the owner of a trade-mark adopted and used, and now being used, and desiring to file the same for record in the office of the Secretary of the State of Wyoming, does hereby certify:

1. The name of the corporation so filing is Campbell Soup Company,
organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey

3. The class of merchandise for which said trademark has been and/or is intended to be used is:
