6 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-4-202(a) is amended to read:

8 **27-4-202. Minimum wage rates.**

10 (a) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her
11 employees, wages at a rate of not less than one dollar and
12 forty cents (\$1.40) per hour from June 1, 1971, to December
13 31, 1971; one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per hour from
14 January 1, 1972 to December 31, 1972; and ~~one dollar and~~

1 ~~sixty cents (\$1.60)~~ five dollars and fifteen cents (\$5.15)
2 per hour, thereafter.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2000.
