1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 39-6-302(a) and (e) and 39-6-305(j)
 2 and (k)(iv) relating to distribution of revenues into the
 3 permanent mineral trust fund; transferring certain tax
 4 revenues previously earmarked for the permanent mineral
 5 trust fund to the budget reserve account through June 30,
 6 1992; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 39-6-302(a) and (e) and 39-6-305(j)
 9 and (k)(iv) are amended to read:

10 39-6-302. Excise taxes on extraction of minerals.

11 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (h) of

1 this section, there is levied an excise tax of two percent
2 (2%) of the value of the gross product extracted upon the
3 privilege of severing or extracting uranium, trona, coal
4 except underground coal, petroleum, natural gas, oil shale
5 or any other fossil fuel in the state. An excise tax of
6 one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) shall be levied on
7 underground coal. The proceeds from this tax shall be
8 deposited into the permanent Wyoming mineral trust fund
9 except as otherwise provided by W.S. 39-6-305(b) and
10 except for the period beginning on the effective date of
11 this act and ending June 30, ~~1991~~ 1992 during which the
12 proceeds shall be deposited as follows:

13 (i) One-fourth (1/4) of the proceeds from coal
14 (except underground coal), petroleum, natural gas, oil
15 shale or any other fossil fuel SHALL BE DEPOSITED into the
16 budget reserve account;

17 (ii) All of the proceeds from uranium and trona
18 SHALL BE DEPOSITED into the budget reserve account.

19 (e) In addition to the other excise taxes provided by
20 this section, there is levied an excise tax on the privi-
21 lege of extracting coal except underground coal of one-
22 half of one percent (1/2%) of the value of the gross prod-

1 uct extracted. The proceeds from the tax shall be depos-
2 ited into the permanent Wyoming mineral trust fund, except
3 for the period beginning on the effective date of this act
4 and ending June 30, ~~1991~~ 1992 the proceeds shall be depos-
5 ited in the budget reserve account.

6 39-6-305. General disposition of revenue collected.

7 (j) The state treasurer shall transfer revenue col-
8 lected under W.S. 39-6-302(e) to the permanent Wyoming
9 mineral trust fund, except for the period beginning on the
10 effective date of this act and ending June 30, ~~1991~~ 1992
11 the revenue shall be transferred to the budget reserve
12 account.

13 (k) The state treasurer shall transfer revenue col-
14 lected under W.S. 39-6-302(g) to the trust and agency fund
15 to be distributed as follows:

16 (iv) One-twelfth (1/12) to the permanent mineral
17 trust fund, except for the period beginning on the effec-
18 tive date of this act and ending June 30, ~~1991~~ 1992 to the
19 budget reserve account;

20 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1990.
