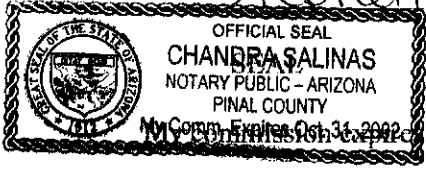

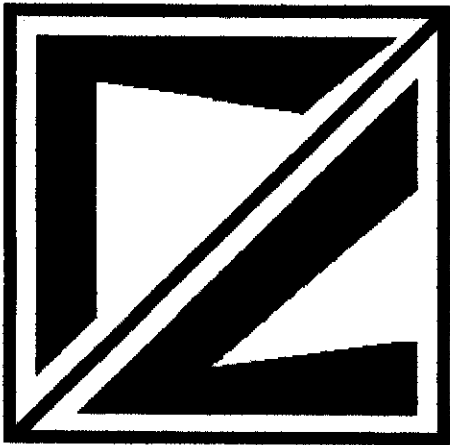

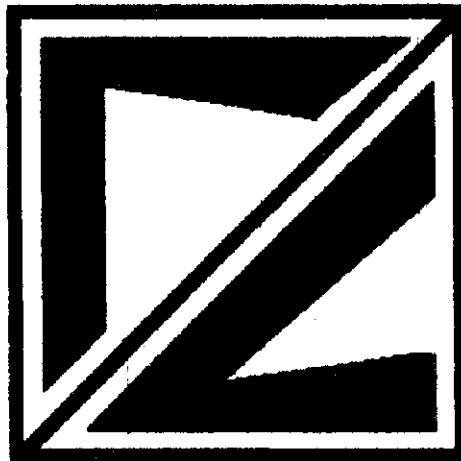

Executive Summary: ROCKLITE, Inc. is a consolidation of the following corporations.

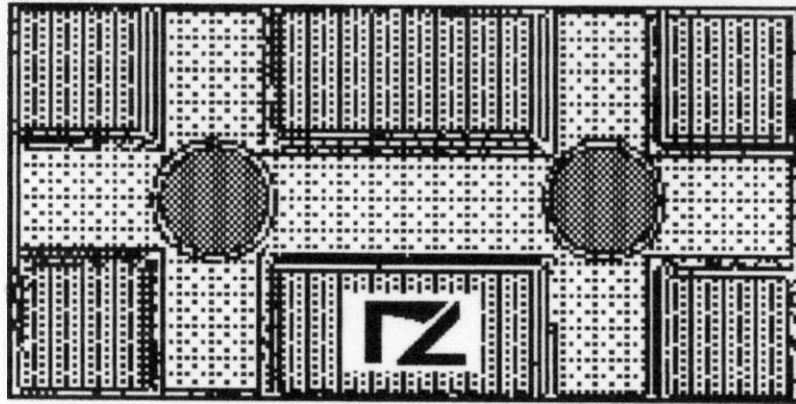
- K.B. & S. LLC - Equipment and Land Holding, established in 1968.
- D.Q.M. - Resources & Mining, established in 1990.
- K.P. & S. - Technical Building and Technical Construction, Aggregates and Materials.
- Rockline, Inc. in Arizona, which held patents and trademarks for environmental and water clean up, established in 1997.

The company is now positioned in one of the fastest growing segments of the building materials manufacturing market. By purchasing all of the outstanding shares of an Arizona S-corporation involved in several facets of the building industry, together with several technologies, business practices and goodwill, ROCKLITE, Inc. is positioned for a fantastic growth rate. It has also continued a process of research and development that cost in excess of \$2.5 million and represents 1000's of hours of research in conjunction with universities and government agencies. All of this research resulted in an invitation for a doctorate program at a major institution. Most importantly, we know where to look for the good ideas and technologies to benefit the company. The ultimate culmination of the work and research are truly the development of a product, whereby we in America, can build homes, offices and buildings that can last 100's of years, conserving precious energy resources, as the energy demand for these developments would be 30 to 35% of present construction. 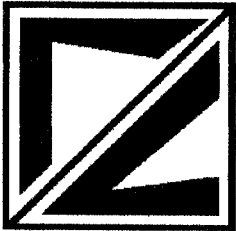
At present, more than 50% of all construction in Europe is with building materials from this type of cement based products. There are specific reasons these materials are used elsewhere in the world and will be addressed later in this business plan. But the main reasons are cost reduction, first at the time of construction and secondly insurance costs, together with heating and cooling costs for the entire lifetime of the structure, which is also much longer, when using this type material.

ROCKLITE Inc. is in a unique position to profit from the current building cycle and become one of the overall industry leaders, using what has been termed, "the building material of the 21st century", by the *PORTLAND CONCRETE ASSOCIATION*, in their 75th anniversary edition of *CONCRETE TECHNOLOGY TODAY*. 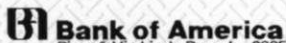

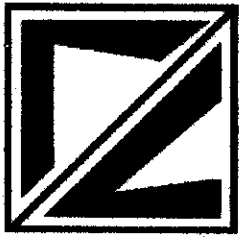

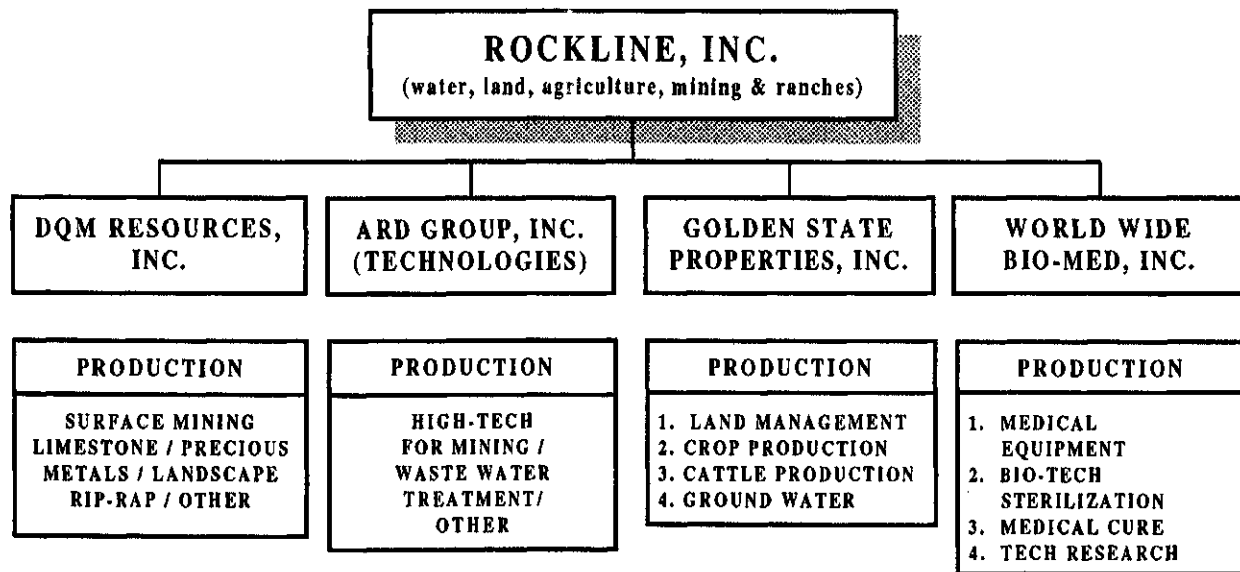

HISTORY & GENERAL INFORMATION

Rockline, Inc. ("Rockline") was incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona on April 24, 1997 and is engaged in the business of resources, their production and technology for related resource projects. Rockline has been authorized by its Articles of Incorporation for issuance of up to 100,000,000 shares of its common stock at .001 par value per share. On July 24, 1997, Rockline acquired 100% of DQM Resources, Inc. (formerly Desert Queen Mines Company L.L.C.) and its 100% interest in KP&S, L.L.C. (operations for DQM); the acquisition was accomplished through an exchange of shares with its principals. On July 24, 1997, as a result of negotiations, Rockline has secured initial contract purchase and terms for acquiring a 100% interest in Golden Green Mining

On July 24, 1997, Rockline reached an accord to purchase via contract and terms, a 28% common stock and co-venture working interest in Americas' Resource Development Group, Inc. ("ARD Group, Inc.") to be held through ("Micro-Star Technologies") a division of Rockline and to be operative upon successful completion of a capital raise sufficient for the establishment thereof and commencement of relative operations / co-interests in same. Other acquisitions have been planned for Rockline and discussion for same has been reserved for future supplementary addenda which may or may not be attached to this Business Plan.
