



7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-3-117 is created to read:

11 **8-3-117. "Bucking Horse and Rider" and related**
12 **trademarks.**

14 (a) The secretary of state shall promulgate rules
15 regulating the licensing or other authorized use of the
16 "Bucking Horse and Rider" and related trademarks.

Source of revenue:

Revenue is generated from royalties paid by private entities for commercial use of the Bucking Horse and Rider (BH&R) trademark. Expenditures will be made to protect, preserve and promote the BH&R trademark. Royalties in excess of expenditures will be deposited to the General Fund.

Assumptions:

Amount of revenue is an estimate only and is based on future royalties generated.

In addition, the Secretary of State's Office may incur administrative expenditures up to \$100,000 per year to protect, preserve, and promote the BH&R trademark.

1 (b) Any licensing fees, royalties or other revenues
2 collected by the secretary of state under this section shall
3 be deposited into an account within the enterprise fund.
4 The legislature shall by appropriation authorize
5 expenditures from the account as necessary to defray
6 administrative expenses associated with licensing of the
7 trademark and expenditures required to protect, preserve and
8 promote the "Bucking Horse and Rider" and related trademarks
9 on behalf of the state.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
13 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14 Constitution.
