### A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to create W.S. 31-8-106 relating to temporary iden-  
2 tification cards; providing for same to be issued to resi-  
3 dents whose driver's license has been suspended or  
4 revoked; providing a description of the card, an expira-  
5 tion date and fees; providing penalties; and providing for  
6 an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 31-8-106 is created to read:

9 31-8-106. Temporary identification cards; issuance;  
10 contents; expiration; fee; penalties, etc.

1           (a) Any Wyoming resident who has a valid Wyoming  
2 driver's license that has been suspended or revoked may be  
3 issued a temporary identification card by the department  
4 certified by the applicant and attested by the department  
5 as to true name, correct age and any other identifying  
6 data the department may require. A space shall be  
7 included wherein an anatomical donor can be identified.  
8 Every application for a temporary identification card  
9 shall be signed and verified by the applicant.

10           (b) The temporary identification card shall not  
11 resemble a Wyoming driver's license. It shall adequately  
12 describe the applicant, bear the applicant's picture, bear  
13 the following:

14 "State of Wyoming" - "Temporary Identification Card  
15 No...." - "This card is provided solely for the purpose of  
16 identification of the person described on the card", and  
17 bear an expiration date.

18           (c) Temporary identification cards shall expire on  
19 the date the suspension or revocation of applicant's  
20 driver's license terminates or one (1) year after the date  
21 of issue whichever is earlier. Not more than thirty (30)  
22 days prior to the expiration of his temporary identifi-  
23 cation card, a person may apply for a new temporary iden-
