4 WHEREAS, imported chilled foreign lamb is currently  
5 savaging the markets served by sheep raisers in the United  
6 States; and

7 WHEREAS, two hundred seventy thousand (270,000) head  
8 of live feeder lambs are expected to flood United States  
9 markets in 1987; and

10 WHEREAS, the American sheep industry is being harshly  
11 impacted economically by imports of lamb from New Zealand

1 and Australia; and

2 WHEREAS, antiprotectionist sentiment in the federal  
3 government, has allowed the American agriculturalist to  
4 suffer; and

5 WHEREAS, the Wyoming legislature supports the sheep  
6 industry of Wyoming and the United States.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-  
8 ISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

9           Section 1. That the Congress of the United States  
10 enact trade legislation to stop imports of live feeder  
11 lambs to the United States from Australia, New Zealand and  
12 other foreign countries.

13           Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming  
14       transmit copies of this Resolution to the President of the  
15       Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives of the  
16       United States and the Wyoming Congressional Delegation.
