- 10 Section 15 of the Wyoming Constitution is proposed for
- 11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the

- 14 majority of the electors. The amendment is as follows:
- 15 Article 6, Section 15. Qualifications for office.
- 16 (a) No person except a qualified elector shall be

- 3 (b) NO PERSON MAY BE ELECTED OR APPOINTED TO MORE
- 4 THAN FOUR (4) TERMS IN THE STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,

- 6 THAN EIGHT (8) COMBINED YEARS AS GOVERNOR, SECRETARY OF
