Amend by inserting in the first line of the title after the word "district" the following, to wit: "and the sixth judicial district," and to define the second judicial district."

Further amend the title by striking out the words "a judge" in line two and insert in lieu thereof the word "judges".

Amend by inserting after the word "Wyoming" in the second line of the first section of the printed bill the following to wit: "The counties of Fremont, Natrona, and Converse shall be and shall compose the Sixth Judicial District of Wyoming, and the counties of Albany and Carbon shall constitute the second Judicial District."

Amend by striking out the words "a judge" as contained in the first line of the third section of the printed bill and insert in lieu thereof the word "judges".

Further amend by inserting after the word "district" in the first line of the third section of the printed bill, the words "and the sixth judicial district".

Amend section four by inserting after the word "district" in the first line of said section four of the printed bill, the words "and a judge of said sixth judicial district."

Further amend section four by striking out the word "this" in the second line of said section four of the printed bill, and insert in lieu thereof the word "therein".

Section 2. The terms of the District Courts of the State of Wyoming shall be as follows: in the County of Lincoln, two terms, one beginning on the first Monday in January, and one beginning on the first Monday in August; in the County of Big Horn, two terms, one beginning on the first Monday in March, and one beginning on the first Monday in September; in the County of Washakie, one beginning on the first Monday in April and one beginning on the first Monday in November; in the County of Hot Springs one beginning on the first Monday in June, and one beginning on the first Monday in December.

Section 3. The Governor shall appoint a judge of the Fifth Judicial District who shall hold office until the first Monday in January succeeding the next general election; and until his successor is duly qualified.

Section 4. At the next general election a judge of said Fifth Judicial District shall be elected who shall take office upon the first Monday in January succeeding his election.

Section 5. Any and every and all matters, litigations and proceedings which may be pending at the time this Act takes effect in any of the District Courts of the State of Wyoming for any of the Counties, which, by this Act are separated from the Judicial Districts of which they were heretofore a part, shall be

An Act to create the Fifth Judicial District of the State of Wyoming, providing for terms of court therein, and providing for the appointment of a judge thereof.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. Fifth Judicial District. The counties of Park, Big Horn, Washakie and Hot Springs shall be and compose the Fifth Judicial District of Wyoming.

Section 2. Terms. Regular terms of the district court in the several counties of the fifth judicial district, or judicial district number five, shall be held each year at the respective county seats of the counties of such district as follows: in the County of Park, two terms, one beginning on the first Monday in January, and one beginning on the first Monday in August; in the County of Big Horn, two terms, one beginning on the first Monday in March, and one beginning on the first Monday in September; in the County of Washakie, one beginning on the first Monday in April and one beginning on the first Monday in November; in the County of Hot Springs one beginning on the first Monday in June, and one beginning on the first Monday in December.

Section 3. The Governor shall appoint a judge of the Fifth Judicial District who shall hold office until the first Monday in January succeeding the next general election; and until his successor is duly qualified.

Section 4. At the next general election a judge of said Fifth Judicial District shall be elected who shall take office upon the first Monday in January succeeding his election.

Section 5. Any and every and all matters, litigations and proceedings which may be pending at the time this Act takes effect in any of the District Courts of the State of Wyoming for any of the Counties, which, by this Act are separated from the Judicial Districts of which they were heretofore a part, shall be

considered to be pending in the District Court of that Judicial District, to which by this Act the said counties in which said matters or proceedings are pending are attached or made a part of, and all such matters shall proceed to final determination in the said Judicial District to which the Counties are attached or made a part of this Act, unless changed in the manner as prescribed by law.

Section 6. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
