6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 18-3-107(b) and by creating a new
 8 subsection (g) is amended to read:

9 18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers; addi-
 10 tional compensation prohibited; exception as to traveling
 11 and other expenses; compensation of county commissioner;

1 appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks, stenogra-
2 phers and other assistants.

3 (b) The salaries provided in subsection (a) OR (g) of
4 this section shall compensate county officers for all of
5 the duties prescribed by law to be performed by them, and
6 no such officer shall receive from federal, state or
7 county funds any additional or separate salary or compen-
8 sation other than as above specified. This restriction
9 shall not apply to traveling and other expenses nor to
10 compensation allowed for office or house rent when
11 expressly provided by law.

12 (g) FROM AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 1995, THE COUNTY ASSES-
13 SOR, FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME COUNTY AND PROSECUTING ATTOR-
14 NEYS, FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME COUNTY ATTORNEYS, COUNTY
15 CLERK, CLERK OF DISTRICT COURT, COUNTY SHERIFF AND COUNTY
16 TREASURER IN THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTIES SHALL RECEIVE AN
17 ANNUAL SALARY DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-
18 SIONERS. SALARIES SHALL BE PAID IN EQUAL MONTHLY
19 INSTALLMENTS. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF EACH
20 COUNTY SHALL MEET NOT LATER THAN JUNE 1, 1994, AND ON OR
21 BEFORE THE SAME DATE EACH FOUR (4) YEARS THEREAFTER, FOR
22 THE PURPOSE OF SETTING SALARIES, WHICH SHALL NOT BE
23 CHANGED DURING THE TERM OF EACH OFFICIAL FOR WHOM A SALARY

1 IS DETERMINED.

2 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1991.
