Re: IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMISSION, ON ITS OWN MOTION, REQUIRING ZEN COMMUNICATIONS, LLC, TO SHOW CAUSE WHY ITS REGISTRATION AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES SHOULD NOT BE CANCELLED DUE TO ITS NONCOMPLIANCE WITH WYOMING LAW - DOCKET NO. 60042-1-RI-21 (RECORD NO. 15701)

LETTER ORDER

(Issued February 26, 2021)

This matter is before the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) upon its own motion requiring Zen Communications, LLC (the Company) to show cause why its registration authority to provide wireless telecommunication services; within the state of Wyoming, should not be revoked and canceled due to its non-compliance with Wyoming law.

The Company is a wireless telecommunications company as defined by Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-103(a)(xi); and as such, subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-401.

The Commission was notified by the Department of Revenue (DOR) that the Company failed to meet the reporting requirements of Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-106 through 37-2-109, relating to the uniform assessment of public utilities. Therefore, the Commission issued its *Show Cause Order and Notice Setting Public Hearing (Show Cause Order)* on February 1, 2021, directing the Company to appear before the Commission on March 2, 2021, in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming and show cause why its registration authority to provide wireless telecommunications services should not be revoked and canceled. The *Show Cause Order* further advised the Company that failure to correct the above-described violation or to appear at the public hearing would result in a default judgment against the Company and its registration authority to provide wireless telecommunications services in Wyoming would be immediately canceled.

The Commission received notification from DOR Staff on February 12, 2021, advising the Company had responded to DOR's pending assessment statements and is no longer in non-compliance.

The Commission finds and concludes that the Company is compliant with the reporting and assessment requirements of Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-106 through 37-2-109.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Zen Communications, LLC is compliant with Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-106 through 37-2-109. This show cause proceeding is dismissed and the docket is closed.
2. This *Letter Order* is effective immediately.
