Enrolled Act No. 37, House of Representatives sixteenth legislature of the state of wyoming

AN ACT to smend and re-enact Section 1119 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes 1920, relating to the Salaries of Justices of the Supreme Court and Judges of the District Courts.

BE IT REACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

be and the same is hereby smended and re-enacted so as to read as follows, to-wit:- "Section 1119. The Justices of the Supreme Court shall each receive an annual salary of Seven thousand dollars (\$7,000,00) and the Judges of the District Court shall receive an annual salary of Sixty five hundred dollars (\$6500.00) which shall be paid in monthly installments at the end of each month, and upon request, the state auditor shall draw warrants upon the state treasurer accordingly, in favor of said Justices and Judges; such increase of salary shall not apply to, or affect the salary of, any such Justice or Judge now in office during his present term, but during their present terms respectively the Justices and Judges now in office shall receive the salary now provided by law".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
