A BILL

for

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 37-134, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended and re-enacted by Section 1, Chapter 157, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1959, providing for certain exemptions from the Motor Carrier Act; and establishing a yearly fee in lieu of a compensatory fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 37-134, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended and re-enacted by Section 1, Chapter 157, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1959, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

This act shall not apply to motor carriers operating wholly within the confines of any Wyoming municipality or motor carriers transporting persons or property to and from such municipality to airports considered adjacent thereto, nor to transportation in his own motor vehicle or combination of vehicles having an unladen weight of less than * * * ^{11,000} TWENTY THOUSAND (20,000) pounds by any farmer or rancher, or the employee of said farmer or rancher exclusively in his service, transporting produce or commodities for his own use to and from his farm or ranch, nor to the exchange of transportation in their own motor vehicles or combination of vehicles having an unladen weight of less than * * * ^{11,000} TWENTY THOUSAND (20,000) pounds by farmers or ranchers, or the employees of said farmers or ranchers exclusively in their service, when such exchange is between farmers or ranchers, or their employees, in the immediate community, nor to the exclusive transportation of children to and from school nor to transportation by motor vehicle when such motor vehicle is owned and operated by the United States, State of Wyoming, or any subdivision thereof, nor to the exclusive transportation of the United States mail; provided, however, that any owner or operator of any motor vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer being driven, hauled or conveyed under the authority of a Wyoming
