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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State Treasury of the State of Wyoming, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and twenty one dollars and fifty cents (\$221.50) or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the relief of Charlie W. Dow, for personal services performed and for expenses incurred for labor and material, approved and certified to, by the State Board of Control, in leveling and building cement side walk in front of State Armory Building as provided for in the ordinance of the town of the City, of Newcastle.

Section 2. Provided that payment of this claim be made by the Secretary-Treasurer, of the State Board of Control upon vouchers audited by him and approved by the Governor.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
