1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend Wyoming Constitution
 2 Article 20, Section 1 relating to amendments to the
 3 Wyoming Constitution; providing that an amendment to the
 4 Wyoming Constitution may be adopted by a majority of the
 5 electors who vote on the amendment.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
 7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
 8 separately, concurring therein:

9 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
 10 Constitution, Article 20, Section 1 is proposed for sub-
 11 mission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
 12 next general election for approval or rejection, to become

1 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a
2 majority of the electors voting at the election:

3 Article 20, Section 1. How amendments proposed by
4 legislature and submitted to people. Any amendment or
5 amendments to this constitution may be proposed in either
6 branch of the legislature, and, if the same shall be
7 agreed to by two-thirds of all the members of each of the
8 two houses, voting separately, such proposed amendment or
9 amendments shall, with the yeas and nays thereon, be
10 entered on their journals, and it shall be the duty of the
11 legislature to submit such amendment or amendments to the
12 electors of the state at the next general election, and
13 cause the same to be published without delay for at least
14 twelve (12) consecutive weeks, prior to said election, in
15 at least one newspaper of general circulation, published
16 in each county. ; -and If a majority of the electors WHO
17 VOTE ON ANY AMENDMENT shall ratify the same, such THAT
18 amendment or-amendments shall become a part of this con-
19 stitution.

20 Section 2. The Secretary of State shall endorse the
21 following statement on the proposed amendment:

1 The adoption of this amendment would make an amendment
2 to the Wyoming Constitution effective if a majority of the
3 electors who vote on the amendment vote in favor of rati-
4 fying. Currently, an elector who does not vote on an
5 amendment has the same effect as a negative vote.
