- 3 Article 20, Section 1. How amendments proposed by legislature and submitted to people. Any amendment or 4 5 amendments to this constitution may be proposed in either branch of the legislature, and, if the same shall be 6 7 agreed to by two-thirds of all the members of each of the two houses, voting separately, such proposed amendment or 8 amendments shall, with the yeas and nays thereon, be 9 10 entered on their journals, and it shall be the duty of the 11 legislature to submit such amendment or amendments to the 12 electors of the state at the next general election, cause the same to be published without delay for at least 13 twelve (12) consecutive weeks, prior to said election, in 14 at least one newspaper of general circulation, published 15 in each county. 7-and If a majority of the electors WHO 16 17 VOTE ON ANY AMENDMENT shall ratify the same, such THAT 18 amendment or-amendments shall become a part of this 19 stitution.
- Section 2. The Secretary of State shall endorse the following statement on the proposed amendment:

The adoption of this amendment would make an amendment to the Wyoming Constitution effective if a majority of the electors who vote on the amendment vote in favor of ratifying. Currently, an elector who does not vote on an amendment has the same effect as a negative vote.
