- 6 Section 1. W.S. 21-349 is amended by amending sub-7 section (b) and by creating a new subsection (c) to read:
- 8 <u>21-349. Same: qualification of students: authorizing</u>
 9 payment of tuition costs and alternatives.

10 (b) In addition to the requirements of subsection 11 (a) of this section, before expending any funds the board 12 of trustees shall obtain an agreement from each student 13 whereby the student agrees to:

14 (i) Authorize the state of Wyoming to pay all15 tuition costs incurred in his or her medical DR DENTAL

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education as determined by any contract between the state 1 of Wyoming and the school of medicine OR SCHOOL OF 2 DENTISTRY providing that education; and 3 4 (ii) Actively engage in professional practice or other professional pursuits in Wyoming for a-period-of 5 time not to-exceed LESS THAN three (3) years as the board 6 7 requires; the-taking-of OR (iii) TAKE a family practice residency program 8 in the state may-be-substituted in lieu of the practice 9 requirements; or 10 t+i+j(iv) Repay all amounts expended by the 11 state of Wyoming under paragraph (i) OF THIS SUBSECTION on 12 the student's education upon such terms as specified by 13 14 the board. (c) IF THE STUDENT PRACTICES HIS PROFESSION 15 IN WYOMING, THE MEDICAL OR DENTAL BOARD SHALL CREDIT ONE-16 17 THIRD (1/3) OF THE TUITION EXPENDITURES AS DEFINED IN W.S. 21-439(b)(i), TOGETHER WITH INTEREST, TO THE STUDENT FOR 18 EACH YEAR OF SUCH PRACTICE AS CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD. 19

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
