THIRTIETH STATE LEGISLATURE OF
THE STATE OF WYOMING


AN ACT limiting administrative expenses of the Workmen's Compensation Department of the State Treasurer's office for the two years ending March 31, 1951, and providing for a control of such expenditures.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:


Section 1. The Workmen's Compensation Department of the State Treasurer's office is authorized to expend from the Industrial Accident Fund not to exceed One Hundred Sixty Thousand (\$160,000.00) Dollars for administrative expenses in carrying out the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation law for the two years ending March 31, 1951.


Section 2. The Workmen's Compensation Department shall comply with the provisions of the Budget Act insofar as expenditures for administrative purposes are concerned.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after March 31, 1949.

Chapter 6

AN ACT limiting administrative expenses of the Workmen's Compensation Department of the State Treasurer's office for the two years ending March 31, 1951, and providing for a control of such expenditures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. The Workmen's Compensation Department of the State Treasurer's office is authorized to expend from the Industrial Accident Fund not to exceed One Hundred Sixty Thousand (\$160,000.00) Dollars for administrative expenses in carrying out the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation law for the two years ending March 31, 1951.

Section 2. The Workmen's Compensation Department shall comply with the provisions of the Budget Act insofar as expenditures for administrative purposes are concerned.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after March 31, 1949.
