AN ACT TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION _____, CHAPTER _____, SESSION LAWS OF WYOMING, 1922, RELATIVE TO THE CREATION OF HOSPITAL DISTRICTS AND DEFINING THE POWERS OF HOSPITAL DISTRICTS, TO CLARIFY THE TERMS USED IN THIS ACT AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE, and declaring the existence of an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

SECTION 1. THAT SECTION _____, CHAPTER _____, SESSION LAWS OF WYOMING, 1922, BE AMENDED AND RE-ENACTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

§1. EACH DISTRICT SO ESTABLISHED IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE A BODY CORPORATE BY THE NAME AND STYLE OF THE _____ HOSPITAL DISTRICT AND THE NAME THEREOF SHALL BE ENTERED UPON THE COMMISSIONER'S RECORD AND SHALL BE KEPT BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE DISTRICT OR A PORTION THEREOF IS LOCATED. IN THE SAME MANNER THE DISTRICT MAY HOLD PROPERTY AS A PARTY TO CONTRACTS, SHALL HAVE POWER TO SUE AND BE SUED, SHALL BE EMPowered TO HOLD AND COVERING DEEDS TO ACQUIRE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY AND TO PRESENT FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES BY GIFT, DEVISE, BEQUEST OR PURCHASE AND TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE ACQUISITION OR PURCHASE OR LEASE OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY AND CONTRACTS TO CONVEY, LEASE AND OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ITS PROPERTY FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES AND AS A HOSPITAL DISTRICT, TO ESTABLISH SINKING FUNDS FOR GATE FUNDING, TO ISSUE BONDS FOR THE PURCHASE OR REAL PROPERTY OR IMPROVEMENTS AND TO PRESENT FOR THE SAME, FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES IN THE MANNER HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, AND THE TRUSTEES THEREOF SHALL HAVE POWERS AS TO SUCH BILLS AND RELATIONS AS ARE NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER OPERATION OF THE DISTRICT.

(1) "HOSPITAL" AND "HOSPITAL PURPOSES" SHALL MEAN ANY INSTITUTION, PLACE, BUILDING, OR AGENCY IN WHICH ANY ACCOMMODATION IS MAINTAINED, FURNISHED OR OFFERED FOR THE HOSPITALIZATION OF THE SICK OR INJURED OR CARE OF ANY PERSON OR CARE OF ANY PERSONS REQUIRING OR RECEIVING CHRONIC OR CONValesCENT CARE, AND SHALL INCLUDE PUBLIC HEALTH CENTERS, AND OTHER TYPES OF HOSPITALS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GENERAL, TUBERCULOSIS, MENTAL, AND CHRONIC DISEASE HOSPITALS, AND ALSO MEDICAL FACILITIES, AND RELATED FACILITIES.

(2) "MEDICAL FACILITIES" INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO DIAGNOSTIC OR TREATMENT CENTERS, REHABILITATION FACILITIES, AND NURSE HOMES, AS THESE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN THE FEDERAL ACT PUBLIC LAW 423, CHAPTER 15, JULY 12, 1954 (6 U.S.C. 2024(c) - (f), STAT. 905-906).

(3) "RELATED FACILITIES" MEANS BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO LABORATORIES, OUT-PATIENT DEPARTMENTS, NURSE HOMES AND NURSE TRAINING FACILITIES, AND CENTRAL SERVICE FACILITIES OPERATED IN CONNECTION WITH HOSPITALS, BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY FACILITY FURNISHING PRIMARILY DOMICILIARY CARE.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS AN EMERGENCY EXISTS, THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE.
