**LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL STUDY OF WORKMEN'S  
COMPENSATION**

AN ACT providing for the Legislative Research Council, cooperating with insurance companies, to study Workmen's Compensation coverage by private insurance companies and through self insurance and to make recommendations regarding amendments to present statutes to allow such private insurance or self insurance.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Council Directed to Study Workmen's Compensation by Private  
or Self Insurance**

**Section 1.** The Legislative Research Council, in cooperation with insurance companies or an association of insurance companies, is directed to conduct a study of Workmen's Compensation coverage by private insurance companies and Workmen's Compensation coverage

through self insurance, and to make recommendations to the Thirty-Eighth Legislature regarding possible amendments to the present statutes which would allow employers, if they should desire, to provide Workmen's Compensation coverage through private insurance companies, or through self insurance, as alternatives to, or in addition to, the present coverage under the Industrial Accident Fund administered by the State of Wyoming.
