#### CHAPTER 76

Original House Bill No. 221

#### HIGHWAY - SIZE AND WEIGHT LIMITS

AN ACT to amend W.S. 31-5-1002(a)(v)(K) and (vi) relating to highway size and weight limits; increasing the limitations on the weight limit formula from 80 feet to 95 feet; conforming the weight table; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

**Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-1002(a)(v)(K) and (vi) is amended to read:

### 31-5-1002. General requirements.

- (a) All vehicles operated on the highways of this state shall comply with the following:
  - (v) Weights:
- (K) The following general formula is applied in preparing gross weight Table I:

Where: W = overall gross weight on any group of two (2) or more consecutive axles to the nearest five hundred (500) pounds, up to a maximum of one hundred seventeen thousand (117,000) pounds.

L = distance in feet between extremes of any group of two (2) or more consecutive axles with a maximum limitation of not more than ninety-five (95) feet applied to the general formula.

N = number of axles in the group under consideration with a maximum limitation of not more than nine (9) axles applied to the general formula.
