INK BLEEDING THRU
FROM REVERSE SIDE

A BILL

for

AN ACT to provide for the office of bill clerk of the senate and house of
representatives of the legislature of the state of Wyoming, ~~defining his duties~~
~~and fixing~~
~~his compensation.~~

Be it enacted by the legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1.—There shall be a bill clerk of the Senate and House of Representatives ~~of~~ of the Legislature of the State of Wyoming, who shall have charge of the receipt, distribution and mailing, of all bills, resolutions and memorials, introduced in the respective branches of the legislature, and who shall perform such other duties as he may be directed to perform by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Said Bill Clerk shall be paid the sum of \$5.00 per day for his services and he shall receive no other compensation perquisite or allowance whatever.

Section 2.—This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
