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

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 31-13-104(e) and 31-13-108 by creat-
 8 ing new subsections (d) and (e) are amended to read:

9 31-13-104. Abandonment on highway or property;
 10 removal; presumption of abandonment; title to impounded

10 (d) ANY VEHICLE LEFT UNATTENDED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
11 WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF THE OWNER OR PERSON IN LAW-
12 FUL CONTROL OF THE PROPERTY FOR AT LEAST THIRTY (30) CON-
13 SECUTIVE DAYS MAY BE SOLD BY THE OWNER OR PERSON IN CON-
14 TROL OF THE PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION TO THE HIGHEST BID-
15 DER. NOTICE OF SALE SHALL BE GIVEN BY REGISTERED MAIL IN
16 WRITING TO THE OWNER AND LIENHOLDER OF RECORD, IF THEY CAN
17 BE IDENTIFIED THROUGH REASONABLE EFFORTS, THE SHERIFF, AND
18 BY PUBLICATION ONCE PER WEEK FOR TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE WEEKS
19 IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE
20 THE VEHICLE WAS IMPOUNDED, NOT LESS THAN TEN (10) DAYS
21 PRECEDING THE DATE OF SALE. THE NOTICE SHALL CONTAIN A
22 FULL DESCRIPTION OF THE VEHICLE WITH ENGINE AND SERIAL
23 NUMBERS IF ANY, THE AMOUNT OF MONEY CLAIMED THEREON FOR

1 EXPENSES INCIDENT TO STORAGE AND REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS,
2 IF ANY, AND THE TIME AND PLACE OF SALE. ALL PROCEEDS FROM
3 THE SALE MAY BE RETAINED BY THE PERSON SELLING THE VEHICLE
4 AND ALL LIENS ON THE VEHICLE ARE EXTINGUISHED. UPON
5 RECEIPT OF SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE FROM THE SELLER THAT HE
6 HAS COMPLIED WITH THIS SECTION AND SOLD THE VEHICLE, THE
7 SHERIFF SHALL EXECUTE A CERTIFICATE OF SALE IN DUPLICATE.
8 W.S. 31-13-109 AND 31-13-110(a) APPLY TO ANY SALE UNDER
9 THIS SUBSECTION. AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO A SALE UNDER THIS
10 SUBSECTION, THE OWNER OR LIENHOLDER OF RECORD MAY RECLAIM
11 THE VEHICLE UPON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES INCIDENT TO STORAGE,
12 REPAIR AND IMPROVEMENT, IF ANY. STORAGE EXPENSES SHALL BE
13 COMPUTED AT THE RATE OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) PER DAY.

14 (e) NO PERSON SHALL SELL A VEHICLE UNDER SUBSECTION
15 (d) OF THIS SECTION IF THE SHERIFF PROVIDES THE PERSON
16 WISHING TO SELL THE VEHICLE A WRITTEN ORDER PROHIBITING
17 THE SALE. THE ORDER SHALL BE SERVED ON THE PERSON SELLING
18 THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO THE SALE AND SHALL NOT BE ISSUED
19 EXCEPT FOR GOOD CAUSE.

20 Section 2. This act is effective June 11, 1986.
