17 15-5-403. Eligibility for service pension.

1 (a) A member is eligible to receive a service pension 2 after he has terminated employment beginning with the month 3 when he has ten (10) four (4) years of credited service and 4 has attained age fifty-five (55) fifty (50).

6 (c) An inactive member with a vested right to a

(a) A pension payable under this article may shall be 1 adjusted beginning in the year the retired member attains 2 age fifty-five (55) fifty (50), or in the case of disability 3 and survivor's pensions, beginning in the year next 4 following twelve (12) months of payments, in accordance with 5 changes in the consumer price index, but not below the 6 original pension amount nor above the original pension 7 8 amount increased by four percent (4%)—five percent (5%) per 9 year, uncompounded.

11 (b) An increase in benefits under this subsection is
12 effective only upon a determination that the increase is
13 actuarially sound. Actuarial determinations pursuant to
14 this subsection shall be reported annually to the governor
15 and the joint appropriations interim committee.

17 **Section 2.** W.S. 15-5-403(b) and 15-5-410 are repealed.
