7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 35-221.12 is created to read:

11 (a) The motor vehicle division of the department of  
12 revenue and taxation shall adopt and implement a program  
13 whereby anatomical organ donors may be so identified by an  
14 appropriate decal, sticker or other marking to be affixed  
15 to the driver's license of the person.

1           (b) The division shall provide space on every appli-  
2 cation for a driver's license or renewal thereof in which  
3 the applicant may indicate his desire to have the marking  
4 provided in subsection (a) of this section on his driver's  
5 license. In addition, any person whose license has not  
6 expired or who has already obtained a license may have the  
7 marking affixed by the division upon request.

8           (c) The division shall publish the existence of the  
9 program along with information regarding the procedures  
10 for having the marking affixed to a license.

11          (d) The division shall notify its counterparts in
