



A BILL

FOR

AN ACT providing for issuance of temporary permits to practice medicine or osteopathy in the State of Wyoming, covering mode of application, qualifications, fees, filing, number of permits, locum tenens agreement, and providing an effective date for this Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. The State Board of Medical Examiners is hereby authorized to issue temporary permits to practice medicine or osteopathy to any person

- (a) who shall have made a proper application for licensure
- (b) has all the required qualifications for such license
- (c) has paid the prescribed fees

as required by Sections 33-327 through 33-343, Chapter 23, Title 33, Wyoming Statutes, 1957.

Section 2. Such permit, when issued and filed in the Office of the Gounty Glerk in the same manner as a license, shall authorize the person receiving the same to practice within the limits of his permit until the date of the next examination.

Section 3. No more than one such temporary permit shall be issued to any one person, at the decision of the board.

Section 4. No physician or osteopath may enter into a locum tenens agreement, nor turn his practice over to a physician, who does not hold a license or temporary permit in the State of Wyoming.

Section 5. The fee for such permit will be Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, this sum not to be applied to other fees for regular licensure or any other fee. Section 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
