AN ACT providing for the relief of The Shoshone  
Irrigation District in payment of assessments  
for construction charges, and operation and  
maintenance of irrigation system for state  
school land.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds of the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900), or so much thereof as may be required, for the relief of The Shoshone Irrigation District in payment of construction charges due to or to become due to the United States of America for construction charges levied or assessed or to be levied or assessed for the years 1927, 1928, 1929 and 1930, against Lot Fifty-nine (59), Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range ninety-nine (99) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
