AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 9-417, Wyoming Statutes 1957,
relating to the transportation of new inmates to the Wyoming Girls'
School and providing that such transportation may be furnished by
the school.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 9-417, Wyoming Statutes 1957, is amended
and re-enacted to read as follows:

Every clerk of any court by which a girl shall be sentenced to said
institute shall at once * * * NOTIFY the superintendent of the institute
* * *, WHO SHALL DISPATCH AN EMPLOYEE to transport the girl, together
with the record of the girl's trial and conviction, as made up by the clerk from
the court records, to the Wyoming Girls' School. * * * IN THE PERFORMANCE
OF THIS DUTY SUCH EMPLOYEE SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR REASONABLE TRAVEL
EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT STATE POLICIES.
