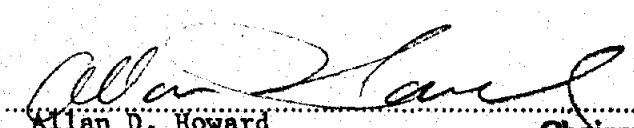

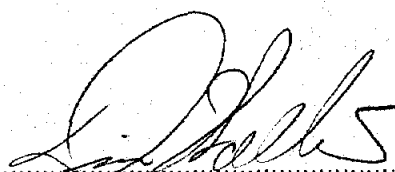

9 (a) Services and supplies authorized for medical
10 assistance under this chapter include:

1 (x) Early and periodic screening, diagnosis and
2 treatment for categorically-eligible individuals who have
3 not attained the age of twenty-one (21) years including:
4 {A}--Screening;--{B}--The--professional--services---of---a
5 licensed--dentist;--{C}--Eyeglasses-and-if-necessary,-con-
6 tact-lenses;-and-{D}--Hearing-aids-with-appropriate--test-
7 ing IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE XIX OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL
8 SECURITY ACT.

9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1992.
