AN ACT to amend and re-enact Sub-sections (b) (d) and (e), Section 19, Chapter 102, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, allocating certain collections from the selective sales tax of 1937 to the State Department of Public Welfare for general welfare purposes, to the State Treasurer for homestead property exemption fund and to exempt monies received under the provisions of said Chapter from the provisions of Sections 92-101, 92-127, 92-128, and 92-129, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 1931.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Sub-section (b) of Section 19, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

(b) To the State Department of Public Welfare, for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1939, and each fiscal year thereafter, the sum of \$500,000.00 (Five Hundred Thousand Dollars), payable in equal monthly installments * * * for distribution by the State Department of Public Welfare as provided by law, PROVIDING THAT TO THE SAID SUM OF \$500,000.00 (FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS) THERE SHALL BE ADDED ANY MONTHLY EXCESS IN THE SALES TAX FUND DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1939 OR ANY FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, AFTER THE CREDITS AND TRANSFERS PROVIDED IN SUB-SECTIONS (a) (c) and (d) SHALL BE DEDUCTED, SUCH EXCESS TO BE TRANSFERRED MONTHLY TO THE CREDIT OF SAID STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MORE ADEQUATELY PROVIDING FOR AND AUGMENTING FEDERAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO OLD AGE PENSIONS TO CITIZENS WHO

MAY QUALIFY UNDER THE LAWS PROVIDING FOR PENSIONS UNDER THE GENERAL WELFARE ACTS.

Section 2. That Sub-section (d), Section 19, Chapter 102, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, shall be and the same is hereby re-enacted to read as follows:

(d) To the State Treasurer for a fund to be known as the "Homestead Property Exemption Fund," the sum of \$340,000.00 (THREE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS) to be paid to the SEVERAL COUNTY TREASURERS of Wyoming FOR PURPOSES OF REIMBURSEMENT TO MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR LOSS OF REVENUES SUSTAINED BY THE WORKINGS OF THE HOMESTEAD PROPERTY EXEMPTION LAW and for no other purpose.

Section 3. That Sub-section (e), Section 19, Chapter 102, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

(e) * * * All monies received under the provisions of this Act shall be exempt from the provisions of Section 92-101, 92-127, 92-128, and 92-129, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 1931.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
