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

Sales of motor vehicles on Sunday.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to create W.S. 31-60.1; and to amend W.S. 31-53 by
2 creating new subsection (f) and 31-60 relating to sales of
3 motor vehicles; providing that motor vehicles may not be
4 sold on Sunday; providing for severability and providing
5 penalties.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 31-60.1 is created to read:

8 31-60.1. Sales on Sunday prohibited. No person
9 whether possessing a certificate under this act or not
10 shall keep open, operate or assist in keeping open any
11 place for the purpose of selling, bartering or exchanging
12 any motor vehicle on Sunday. This section shall not pro-
13 hibit opening an establishment on Sunday for other pur-
14 poses, including the sale of petroleum products, tires,
15 automobile accessories or for the purpose of operating a
16 motor vehicle repair shop, or for supplying services such

1 as towing or wrecking.

2 Section 2. W.S. 31-53 by creating new subsection (f)
3 and 31-60 are amended to read:

4 31-53. Definitions.

5 (f) "THIS ACT" MEANS W.S. 31-18 AND 31-53 THROUGH
6 31-60.1.

7 31-60. Penalty.

8 (a) Any person violating any ~~of--the--provisions~~
9 PROVISION of this act ~~shall-upon-conviction-be--deemed~~ IS
10 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
11 not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or confined
12 in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, or
13 both.

14 (b) IN ADDITION TO THE PENALTY PROVIDED BY SUBSEC-
15 TION (a) OF THIS SECTION, ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF VIOLAT-
16 ING THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 31-60.1 MAY HAVE HIS CERTIF-
17 ICATE TO OPERATE AS A DEALER PURSUANT TO THIS ACT SUS-
18 PENDED FOR UP TO ONE (1) YEAR BY THE COURT.

19 Section 3. The legislature declares that this act is
20 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
21 and safety.

1 Section 4. If any provision of this act or its
2 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid,
3 the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or appli-
4 cations of this act which can be given effect without the
5 invalid provision or application and to this end the
6 provision of this act are declared to be severable.

7 Section 5. This act is effective ninety (90) days
8 after adjournment of the session of the legislature at
9 which it was enacted.
