A BILL

FOR

An Act Exempting Certain Property From Taxation.

February 25 introduced, read first time and referred to Committee No. 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TERRITORY OF
WYOMING:

SECTION 1. The following described property shall be exempt from taxation: Any
2 building, and the land whereon the same is located, while owned by any one person or
3 corporation, or by several persons jointly, or in partnership, at least one-third of which
4 is used as and for the purposes of an opera house, duly licensed as such and which por-
5 tion of said building devoted to such purposes, is provided with a regular and per-
6 manent stage, set with theatrical scenery and appliances, and having the floor of its
7 auditorium constructed upon an incline, or provided with raised seats, and which is de-
8 voted to the production of opera, legitimate drama, and theatrical performances; *Pro-*
9 *vided*, that the land so exempt shall not exceed the amount of land necessarily occupied
10 by, and used in connection with, said building.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

FOR

AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
THE TERRITORY OF WYOMING:

SECTION 1. THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY SHALL BE EXEMPT
FROM TAXATION: ANY BUILDING, AND THE LAND WHEREON THE SAME IS LO-
CATED, WHILE OWNED BY ANY ONE PERSON OR CORPORATION, OR BY SEVERAL
PERSONS JOINTLY, OR IN PARTNERSHIP, AT LEAST ONE-THIRD OF WHICH IS
USED AS AND FOR THE PURPOSES OF AN OPERA-HOUSE, ^{*duly licensed as such*} AND WHICH PORTION OF
SAID BUILDING DEVOTED TO SUCH PURPOSES, IS PROVIDED WITH A REGULAR
AND PERMANENT STAGE, SET WITH THEATRICAL SCENERY AND APPLIANCES, AND
HAVING THE FLOOR OF ITS AUDITORIUM CONSTRUCTED UPON AN INCLINE, OR
PROVIDED WITH RAISED SEATS, AND WHICH IS DEVOTED TO THE PRODUCTION
OF OPERA, LEGITIMATE DRAMA, AND THEATRICAL PERFORMANCES; PROVIDED, THAT
THE LAND SO EXEMPT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF LAND NECESSARILY
OCCUPIED BY, AND USED IN CONNECTION WITH, SAID BUILDING.

SEC. 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND
AFTER ITS PASSAGE.
