

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 28-5-101(a) and (e) is amended to
9 read:

10 28-5-101. Schedule of compensation, per diem and

1 travel expenses.

2 (a) ~~From-and-after-January-1,-1977,~~ Each member of
3 the legislature shall receive ~~thirty~~ SEVENTY-FIVE dollars
4 ~~(\$30.00)~~ (\$75.00) per day as salary and ~~thirty-six~~ SIXTY
5 dollars ~~(\$36.00)~~ (\$60.00) per day for expenses for each
6 calendar day while the legislature is in session, and
7 ~~twelve~~ THIRTY-FIVE cents ~~(\$-12)~~ (\$.35) per mile for neces-
8 sary travel to attend and return from the legislature.
9 THOSE MEMBERS WHO RESIDE TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES OR LESS
10 FROM THE STATE CAPITOL SHALL NOT RECEIVE PER DIEM BUT
11 SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES
12 INCURRED WHILE THE LEGISLATURE IS IN SESSION.

9 diem for each day during which he travels to engage in,
10 return from or engages in an interim activity for which he
11 is entitled to receive salary or an activity approved by
12 the management council or the chairman of an interim com-
13 mittee of which he is a member. The member shall be paid
14 statutory mileage for necessary travel to attend and
15 return from an approved interim activity. STATUTORY
16 SALARY, PER DIEM AND MILEAGE ARE ESTABLISHED IN SUBSECTION
17 (a) OF THIS SECTION.

18 Section 2. W.S. 28-5-101(b) through (d) is repealed.

1 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
4 tution.
