ENROLLED ACT NO. 117, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

FORTY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING  
1985 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to worker's compensation; providing authority to borrow funds to make benefit payments; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. Upon determination of inadequate revenues by the state treasurer, the state treasurer, with the approval of the farm loan board, may utilize interfund loans from the budget reserve account provided by W.S. 9-2-1012(e) in an amount not to exceed fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00) to the worker's compensation general account within the trust and agency fund to pay benefits payable through December 31, 1986 required under the Wyoming Worker's Compensation Act which cannot be paid because of insufficient revenues available to the state treasurer. The loans shall bear no interest and shall be repaid at the time and in the manner prescribed by the legislature with the first payment to commence not later than July 1, 1987 and the loan to be paid in full no later than July 1, 1989.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.

Section 1. Upon determination of inadequate revenues by the state treasurer, the state treasurer, with the approval of the farm loan board, may utilize interest income from the bond-get reserve account provided by W.S. 9-2-1012(e) in an amount not to exceed fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) to the worker's compensation general account within the trust and agency for pay benefits payable through December 31, 1985. The state treasurer shall bear no interest and shall be repaid the amount of the loan in the manner prescribed by the legislature within the time limit to commence not later than July 1, 1987 and the loan shall be paid in full no later than July 1, 1989.



Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
