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An Act Making it a Misdemeanor to fire off any gun, or other fire-arms upon the enclosed Premises of Another, without permission of the owner, lessee or occupant of such premises, and Providing a Penalty for the Violation thereof.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Added to Section 1.

Provided That the owner, lessee or occupant of such premises shall cause such number of notices to be posted on and about said premises, that shooting is forbidden within said enclosure as to give all persons reasonable notice thereof.

Strike out the words "otherwise" in Section 1.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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An Act Making it a Misdemeanor to fire off any gun, or other fire-arms upon the enclosed Premises of Another, without permission of the owner, lessee or occupant of such premises, and Providing a Penalty for the Violation thereof.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. It is hereby made unlawful for any person or persons to fire off any gun or other fire-arms, in hunting ~~on the~~ ~~premises~~, upon the enclosed premises of another, except as he or they may have express permission so to do from the owner, lessee, or occupant of such premises. ^

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and be subject to a fine not to exceed fifty dollars.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
