Local sewer facility appropriation.

Sponsored by: Representative(s) SORENSEN, SHREVE and WALLIS

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to an appropriation of funds for financing  
 2 construction of local sewer facilities not meeting  
 3 requirements of the environmental protection agency; pro-  
 4 viding an appropriation; authorizing the farm loan board  
 5 to award grants and providing rulemaking authority; pro-  
 6 viding for distribution of grants; providing for grant  
 7 application; exempting projects financed under a grant  
 8 from compliance with specified federal regulations; and  
 9 providing for an effective date.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

1           Section 1. Fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00)  
2   is appropriated from the general fund to the state farm  
3   loan board for grants to political subdivisions of the  
4   state to finance construction of sewer facilities not  
5   meeting requirements of permits issued under the national  
6   pollution discharge elimination system. Funds appropri-  
7   ated under this section shall not lapse at the end of any  
8   fiscal year.

9           Section 2. Grants authorized under this appropria-  
10   tion shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the  
11   total project cost except under conditions specified in  
12   W.S. 9-4-604(g)(ii)(A) through (C). Funds shall not be  
13   distributed by the farm loan board until ninety percent  
14   (90%) of federal funds available to the state for any  
15   fiscal year for sewer construction purposes under the fed-  
16   eral environmental protection agency have been obligated.  
17   The farm loan board may use the state priority list  
18   adopted under 40 CFR 35.9.5 pursuant to the federal Clean  
19   Water Act as a guideline for awarding grants and may adopt  
20   regulations in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative  
21   Procedure Act it considers necessary to implement the  
22   grant program.

23           Section 3.

1           (a) Application for grants authorized under Section  
2   1 of this act shall be for two (2) steps, as follows:

3                   (i) Grant application under Step I includes  
4   funding for preparation of a sewer facilities plan. A  
5   Step I plan shall be approved by the farm loan board  
6   before application for a Step II grant under paragraph  
7   (a)(ii) of this section be considered. Any political sub-  
8   division with a facility plan prepared and approved under  
9   a grant from the federal environmental protection agency  
10   is eligible for a Step II grant without Step I plan  
11   approval under this paragraph; and

12                   (ii) Grant application under Step II includes  
13   engineering design and construction of facilities approved  
14   under a Step I plan.

15           Section 4. Projects financed under this act are not  
16   required to comply with federal regulations established  
17   pursuant to Section 201 of the federal Clean Water Act.
