





8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

1 (a) Five hundred fifty thousand dollars
2 (\$550,000.00) is appropriated from the highway fund to be
3 expended by the Wyoming highway department for the devel-
4 opment and construction of a highway rest area at Indepen-
5 dence Rock Historic Site located in Natrona County,
6 Wyoming.

7 (b) For purposes of this section, the Wyoming recre-
8 ation commission shall transfer title to not more than
9 three (3) acres of recreation commission lands within the
10 boundaries of the historic site to the highway department.
11 The lands transferred under this subsection shall provide
12 maximum accessibility by the traveling public.

13 (c) In constructing and maintaining the highway rest
14 area authorized and funded pursuant to this section, the
15 highway department shall:

16 (i) Prioritize rest area construction for com-
17 pletion on or before July 1, 1990;

18 (ii) Develop, operate and maintain the rest
19 area facility and site independent of the recreation com-
20 mission.

1 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
4 tution.

8 to the highway department. The lands transferred under
9 this subsection shall provide maximum accessibility by the
10 traveling public and shall be of an amount required for
11 the development and construction of the rest area with
12 necessary appurtenances including a parking lot, picnic
13 tables and arbors, rest room facilities, sewage and water
14 treatment facilities, but shall not exceed eight (8)
15 acres.


