1 A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to local control of public
2 schools.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
5 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
6 separately, concurring therein:

8 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
9 Constitution Article 7, Sections 1 and 11 is proposed for
10 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
11 next general election for approval or rejection, to become
12 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a
13 majority of the electors voting at the election:

14

15 **Article 7, Section 1. Legislature to provide for**
16 **public schools.** The legislature shall provide for the
17 establishment and maintenance of a ~~complete and uniform~~

1 system of public instruction, embracing free elementary
2 schools of every needed kind and grade, a university with
3 such technical and professional departments as the public
4 good may require and the means of the state allow, and such
5 other institutions as may be necessary. The elementary and
6 secondary schools shall be under the control and management
7 of locally elected boards of trustees, but the legislature
8 may require the degree of uniformity in the public schools
9 it deems appropriate, provided the legislature does not
10 violate the provisions of section 11 of the article. The
11 legislature may provide for the certification of any class
12 of employees of the public schools it deems appropriate and
13 may provide for state controlled schools it deems needed for
14 special purposes.

15

16 **Article 7, Section 11. Textbooks.** Neither the
17 legislature nor the superintendent of public instruction nor
18 any other state agency shall have power to prescribe text
19 books or particular methods of instruction to be used in the
20 public schools.

21

22 **Section 2.** The Secretary of State shall endorse the
23 following statement on the proposed amendment:

24

1 The adoption of this amendment preserves the current
2 practice of local control of the public schools. It
3 overturns that portion of the recent Supreme Court decision
4 that appears to require the legislature to impose a
5 statewide curriculum. It allows the legislature to require
6 the degree of uniformity it deems appropriate, but forbids
7 the legislature from requiring specific textbooks or
8 teaching methods. It allows the legislature to establish
9 qualifications for teachers and other personnel.
