W.S. 21-13-102(a)(i)(A) and (ii)(A) and (c) 9 is amended to read: 10 21-13-102. Maximum rate of 11 school district tax; recapture of excess; equalization of permissive levies. 12 13 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the maximum 14 rate of school district tax that may be levied for all 15 school purposes, exclusive of bond interest and redemption, 16 17 for any school district in any school year on each dollar of assessed valuation within the school district is as follows: 18

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1 (i) In a unified school district: 2 3 4 (A) Twenty-five (25) Twenty-seven (27) mills shall be levied for combined elementary, junior high and 5 high school purposes; and 6 7 8 (ii) In any nonunified school district consisting of kindergarten through grade eight (8): 9 10 (A) Twenty (20) Twenty-two (22) mills shall 11 12 be levied for school purposes; and 13 14 (C) The revenue to be rebated under subsection (b) of this section shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of 15 the difference between the revenue received by a school 16 17 district from the mandatory levies per average daily membership provided by subsection (a) of this section and 18 19 the statewide revenue per average daily membership from 20 twenty-five (25) twenty-seven (27) mills, multiplied by the 21 average daily membership of the school district. Annually, on or before July 15, the department using average daily 22 memberships and assessed valuations from the preceding 23 24 fiscal year, shall compute maximum recapture under this 25 subsection for each district and the final amount of

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recapture computed under subsection (b) of this section for 1 the preceding fiscal year. If any district rebated more 2 revenue to the state during the preceding fiscal year than 3 the maximum computed, or than the amount to be rebated under 4 subsection (b) of this section as computed using actual data 5 6 from the preceding fiscal year, the department shall rebate the excess to the district. If any district rebated less 7 revenue to the state during the preceding fiscal year than 8 the amount to be rebated under subsection (b) of this 9 section, as computed using actual data from the preceding 10 11 fiscal year, the district shall rebate the difference to the 12 state.

14 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as 16 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 17 Constitution.
